The Regional Secretaries shall be the Unit Secretary and will be co-opted with the recommendation of the Module Committee. The Regional Secretaries will not be a member of the Central Committee but they will be part of the Regional Committee. The Regional Secretaries may be removed from office by the Central Committee as per the recommendation of the Module Committee.</p>

The Chairperson, Convener and members of the Women's Sub Committee may be removed from office by the Central Committee as per the recommendation of Module Committee.</p>
