**TRIENNIAL GENERAL BODY MEETING OF THE FEDERATION  
HELD AT INDORE(M.P.) ON THE 25<sup>TH</sup> & 26<sup>TH</sup> DECEMBER 2021

“The Triennial General Body Meeting of All India State Bank of India Staff Federation(AISBISF), which was held as scheduled on 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> December 2021 at Indore was not only the show of Unity that was exhibited by the militant membership of the Federation but also “**A GRAND EXTRAVAGANZA**”.

2. The Inaugural session started with a procession covering a distance of a Kilometer to the venue – the Brilliant Convention Centre, Vijay Nagar, Indore– with Com.Arun Bhagoliwal-President, Com.Sanjeev Kumar Bandlish-General Secretary leading the procession on the well decorated Jeep with a feel of a Chariot being pulled by 5 horses followed by Rathes of All Circles with the General Secretary and President of respective Circles atop the seats and thousands of comrades from all over the Country chanting slogans. The various uniforms provided to the comrades of different Circle affiliates added colours to the well organized and disciplined procession. The sky-high slogans raised by the jubilant comrades such as “All India State Bank of India Staff Federation-Zindabad, Inquilab-Zindabad, Our Unity-Zindabad, etc.” displayed the devotion and commitment of the membership. The dancing beats of “Dhol-Nagara Band” and the bursting of Confetti bursts further enhanced the upbeat mood of the comrades.

The dignitaries were welcomed at the entrance of the meeting venue and the Flag of our mighty Federation was hoisted by Com.Arun Bhagoliwal, President in the presence of Com.Sanjeev Kumar Bandlish, General Secretary, the Presidents and the General Secretaries of all the Circle Affiliates and thousands of comrades from all over the country. The colourful balloons that were also rocketed to the sky, symbolizing the Unity, by all Circle affiliates in various colours during the flag-hoisting were eye-catching and releasing of white pigeons were giving the message of peace.

The prime office-bearers of the Federation and the Management functionaries were escorted to the meeting hall and the enthusiastic comrades attracted the attention of the dignitaries and others with their slogans “AISBISF-Zindabad”, ‘Our Federation-Zindabad’, ‘Our Unity-Zindabad’ and “Our Leaders-Zindabad” and so on.

Subsequent to the cultural programme, the dignitaries viz. Shri Om Parkash Mishra-Dy. Managing Director(HR) & Corporate Development Officer, Shri Binod Kumar Mishra-Chief General Manager-Bhopal Circle and Com.S.C. Balaji were invited to the dais amidst thunderous applause from the audience. The crowd was ecstatic when all circle affiliates’ Presidents and General Secretaries were invited to the dais with the traditional music and dance of their respective States. Com.Arun Bhagoliwal, President, Com.Sanjeev K. Bandlish, General Secretary, felicitated all the dignitaries and executive committee members on the dais. The Inaugurator of the Conference, Shri Om Parkash Mishra, DMD(HR) & Corporate Development Officer, Shri Binod Kumar Mishra-Chief General Manager of Bhopal Circle and the distinguished guest(s) Com.SC Balaji-President of National Confederation of Bank Employees along with Com.Arun Bhagoliwal, President and Com.Sanjeev Kumar Bandlish, General Secretary lighted the lamp confirming the belief that the light acts as a guide and keeps us from stumbling in the dark.

Com.Arun Bhagoliwal, President(AISBISF) and the General Secretary of State Bank of India Award Staff Employees Union Bhopal Circle gave a welcome speech welcoming all the Dignitaries on the Dias and off the Dias and greeted all the Dignitaries, Delegates and Observers to the Conference. Com.Bhagoliwal also thanked the entire Executive of the Federation for providing the exceptional opportunity of hosting the Triennial General Body Meeting of the mighty Federation at Indore(M.P.). 8. Thereafter, the Federation Song was released and sung in the presence of august gathering in the Auditorium which was given a big applause by one and all. After this Com.Arun Bhagoliwal asked Com.Sanjeev K. Bandlish-General Secretary(AISBISF) to come to the podium and address the audience.

Com.Sanjeev Kumar Bandlish, General Secretary of the Federation said that with the pragmatic approach of the management, many issues have been resolved in the last two and a half years and expressed with positivity that resolutions to the remaining issues concerning the employees would also be resolved soon. While conveying his wholehearted thanks to the entire HR Team at Corporate Centre for the co-ordination being extended to the Federation, Com.Sanjeev Kumar Bandlish requested the bank management for early clearance of long pending issues such as Reimbursement of Dental Treatment expenses, Reimbursement of Cost of Spectacles and provision of Annual Health Check-up facility etc. to all Award Staff Employees.

10. Shri Prahlad Thak, An Artist was called to the Dias and Felicitated by Shri O.P. Mishra, DMD&CDO, Com.Arun Bhagoliwal-President and Com.Sanjeev K. Bandlish-General Secretary by presenting a shawl, bouquet and a Memento. Shri Prahlad Thak is famous for making paintings by using foodgrains only. Shri Thak using foodgrains drew portraits of Com.Arun Bhagoliwal-President and Com.Sanjeev K. Com.Balaji recollected the achievements of the past leaders of the Federation and complimented the present leaders for continuing the legacy. Com.Balaji expressed his concern on the issue of privatisation of public sector banks and needs to be totally opposed. Com.Balaji congratulated and advised that the Bank employees could get the ever best XIth Bipartite Wage Settlement under the strong and able leadership of Com.Sanjeev Kumar Bandlish as Convenor of UFBU and General Secretary of NCBE.

16. The Inaugural Session came to an end with the proposal of Vote of Thanks by Com.Nalin Sharma, President of the host Union.

17. The **Delegate Session**, as scheduled, was held on the **26<sup>th</sup> December 2021**, wherein the General Secretary's Report along with Statement of Accounts for the years 2019 & 2020 and the resolutions emanated there from General Secretary's Report were presented by Com. Sanjeev Kumar Bandlish, General Secretary, which was unanimously approved by the General Body, after threadbare discussions. Thereafter, the amendments to the Rules & Constitution of the Federation, as approved by the Council and proposed by the General Secretary were also unanimously approved by the house after detailed discussions.

18. Thereafter, few of the delegates asked certain queries and put forth some demands which were suitably replied by the General Secretary.

19. Subsequent to approval of the item of Agenda relating to appointment of Auditor for auditing the Federation Accounts, the election process was started for election of new office-bearers in the Executive Committee and Council of the Federation with the appointment of Election Officer and Presiding Officer, who asked for the nominations to the various positions for the Executives and Council of the Federation. Since, there was only one nomination for each post though the sets were many so after the scrutiny of the nomination papers and ascertaining that there was no withdrawal so office-bearers to all the positions were declared elected unopposed by the Election Officer.
