"REQUEST FOR CONSIDERATION OF PENDING INTER ADMINISTRATIVE AREA TRANSFER REQUESTS"

We are pleased to note that the Inter Administrative Area transfer (IAT) requests of 73 employees have been approved and released on 13.06.2024. We sincerely thank your good office for the prompt support in releasing this list.

While the IAT has facilitated the movement of some employees who sought transfers, we would like to bring to your attention the pending Inter Administrative Area Transfer requests submitted by Award Staff in our Circle. As of now, 130 transfer requests from clerical employees are pending, with 52 requests dating back to the period between 01.04.2021 and 31.03.2023. The details of such transfer requests are enclosed for your ready reference.

Typically, Inter Administrative Area Transfers in our Circle are considered during the recruitment of Junior Associates. However, in 2023, newly recruited Junior Associates were posted to their home modules, particularly to Thrissur and Kozhikode Modules, where the highest number of transfer requests are pending. We raised this issue in the Circle Consultative Meetings held on 23/06/2023, 19/09/2023 and 03/01/2024 and the CMC assured us that the issue would be resolved positively.

Many employees are awaiting transfers to their home modules to join their spouses, take care of children and aged parents, undergo infertility treatment and for other personal reasons. The delay in processing these transfer requests has created widespread discontent among the employees.

Considering these aspects, we kindly request your good office to consider the pending transfer requests during the allotment of new recruits expected to join in July 2024. We trust that management will take a sympathetic and compassionate approach in this matter.”
