LET US MARCH TOGETHER HISTORIC 9TH GENERAL COUNCIL AT THIRUVANANTHAPURAM (Com. N KOMAL DAS NAGAR)

History teaches that building a strong union is a journey of dedication, commitment and perseverance and every General Council is a mile stone. Befitting its nature the 9th General Council of our beloved and mighty organisation SBSU was held at Com. N. Komal Das Nagar, Girideepam Convention Centre, Thiruvananthapuram on 8th & 9th October, 2023. The meeting was a platform for celebrating our achievements and bidding farewell to our dedicated leader Com. Philip Koshy.

The curtain raiser of the conference was the get together of more than 3500 comrades, who had arrived from every nook and corner of Thiruvananthapuram Circle. The presence of young participants and female comrades was particularly inspiring and added to the vibrant spirit of the conference. The procession was led by our esteemed leaders, including Com. Akhil S, President, Com. Philip Koshy, General Secretary, Com. Sanjeev Kumar Bandlish, General Secretary of AISBISF, and Com. Rajath H C, General Convenor of the Organising Committee. We were joined by leaders from the All India State Bank of India Staff Federation and various Circle affiliates, making the rally a powerful show of unity.

The gathering was greeted with thundering slogans by the State Bank of India Pensioners Association, Kerala under the leadership of Com. A. Jayakumar, General Secretary. At 10.45 a.m. Com.Sanjeev Kumar Bandlish, General Secretary, AISBISF hoisted the flag amidst resounding slogans. Floral tributes were paid to Com. A.P. Gopalakrishnan, Com. V.G.Sidhardhan and Com.N Komal Das by our leaders. Inside the hall, the assembly was mesmerized by the Swagatha Geetham, sung by our comrades Nidhish K, Ganesh.M, Satheesh, Amal K Mannath, Shambhu Namboothiri V, Anoop G, Lekshmi M, Hareesh K K, Karthika Balachandran, Mithu Manoj, Silvia.V, Athira Vijay and Geethanjali Kumar, with lyrics by Com. Karivellur Murali and music composed by Com. Bhash P.K. The inaugural session commenced at the Girideepam Convention Centre with invocation by Com.Mithu Manoj. Com. Rajath H C, General Convenor, welcomed the gathering, followed by the presidential address by Com. Akhil S. Com. Akhil S emphasised the challenges faced by the public sector employees and the relevance of our General Council's motto, "**Strengthen Public Sector and Ensure Democratic Banking**," in the current scenario. He also extended warm wishes to Com. Philip Koshy, General Secretary, who was set to retire on 31st October, 2023.

He emphasised the importance of building strong units at the local level and the need for collective trade union activities. Rakesh K R, Assistant Treasurer, presented the statement of accounts. The session was adjourned at 6:30 p.m., followed by a cultural and musical evening organised under the leadership of Com. On the second day, the Delegates Session began at 10:30 a.m., with Com. Akhil S as President. Com. P M Sreevalsan, Deputy General Secretary, delivered the welcome address. The Leader of the Opposition, Shri. V D Satheesan inaugurated the Delegate Session at 11:30 a.m. He commended the nationalization of banks as a revolutionary decision and cautioned against the growing issue of corporate defaulters seeking refuge in safe havens, which poses a significant challenge to our nation. He also reminded us that India successfully navigated the global economic downturn during the subprime mortgage crisis, primarily due to the resilience of our strong Public Sector Banks. He emphasised that strengthening Public Sector Banks remains crucial for ensuring the nation's continued development.

The Assistant Treasurer clarified the account-related queries raised by the delegates. The council unanimously approved the report and statement of accounts. The resolutions presented were also unanimously approved by the council.

Com. Philip Koshy received a standing ovation for his untiring and relentless service to the organisation. Com. Philip Koshy introduced newly elected office-bearers to the council and thanked the Central Committee and congratulated the dynamic comrades for their contributions to the conference's success. A resolution was unanimously approved by the house congratulating the Organising Committee of the 9th General Council and the entire membership for making the Conference a memorable event in our organisation's history.

The meeting concluded with resounding slogans of "Long Live SBSU and Long Live Trade Union." The President then convened the first meeting of the Central Committee, and co-options for various posts & appointment of external Auditor were approved unanimously.

We lower our flag in solemn remembrance of Com. Jayesh K from the Tirurangadi Branch, who tragically passed away on his onward journey after attending our triennial conference. Our thoughts are with his loved ones during this difficult time.
